SECOND MAN NOW WANTED FOR JURY TAMPERING

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a second man accused of trying to influence the decision of jurors by passing out literature on jury nullification as they entered the Lindsay-Flanigan Courthouse in Denver.

Eric Brandt (dob: 11-19-71) is charged with seven counts of jury tampering (F5).

The charges allege on July 27, 2012, Brandt was staffing a small booth with a sign that said "Juror Info" in front of the courthouse and provided jury nullification flyers to jury pool members.

Brandt remains at large; a warrant for his arrest has been issued. Anyone with information about Brandt is encouraged to contact local law enforcement.

A co-defendant, Mark Iannicelli (dob: 05-05-59), was charged earlier and is scheduled to appear August 11, 2015, for his second advisement in Denver County Courtroom 2100.
