MAN CHARGED WITH JURY TAMPERING

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of trying to influence the decision of jurors by passing out literature on jury nullification as they entered the Lindsay-Flanigan Courthouse in Denver earlier this week.

Mark Iannicelli (dob: 05-05-59) is charged with seven counts of *jury tampering* (F5).

The charges allege that on July 27, 2015, Iannicelli set up a small booth with a sign that said "Juror Info" in front of the courthouse and provided jury nullification flyers to jury pool members.

Iannicelli has been released from custody on a \$5,000 personal recognizance bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on August 11, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
